

How to get there:

Nearby bus stop: bus # 46 stop Vigevano, tram # 4 stop Novara and bus # 51 stop Crispi sud.

From PORTA NUOVA train station and underground: take the tram 4 from bus stop 251 VITTORIO EMA-NUELE II to bus stop 235 NOVARA, and then walk for 5 minutes.

From PORTA SUSA train station and underground: take the bus 46 from bus stop 1218 BOLZANO CAPOLINEA to bus stop 3265 VIGEVANO, and then walk for 1 minute.

In alternative, take the bus 51 from bus stop 1118 BOLZANO CAPOLINEA to bus stop 1211 CRISPI SUD and then walk for 3 minutes.

Public procurement accounts for about 19% of GDP in the European Union and it is an enormous potential market for innovative products and services. Public procurement practices can help foster market uptake of innovation, whilst improving the quality of public services in markets where the public sector is a significant purchaser. PROBIS (Procurement of Building Innovative solutions) is a project funded by European Commission that has the general objective to test Public Procurement for Innovation (PPI) in increasing energy efficiency and sustainability of European buildings.

The project has launched and awarded four public procurement procedures for the refurbishment of buildings with innovative solutions, in Italy, Sweden and Hungary. During the conference, results of the four tenders will be presented and discussed, with the scope to make available to EU public procurers the experiences generated by the project and to analyze the possibility of implementation of further Innovation Procurement actions in the framework of the new EU Public Procurement Directive and national regulations.
