At the beginning of 2021, the Interreg MED Renewable Energy project launched the ETU Initiative. Since then, it has established a collaboration between the project's partners and a group of Mediterranean territories interested in implementing new solutions for their energy transition projects. This experience offered the opportunity to test the ETU Toolbox as a holistic model for the renewable energy transition in these regions.
