- Continuity of the Coordinated and Support Actions (CSA) of the Energy Efficiency area of the Energy Challenge of H2020
- Supports the policy objectives of the EU on sustainable energy, particularly the Green Deal, the Energy Union (energy and climate objectives for 2030), the decarbonization strategy of the European Union for 2050 and REPowerEU
- Aims at: facilitating the transition toward an energy-efficient, renewable energy-based, climate neutral and resilient economy through the support of coordinated and support actions across Europe.
- Support for projects on Energy Efficiency and Renewable Energy
- Budget: 997 million Euros for the period 2021-2027





LIFE - Clean Energy Transition (CET)"What is a Coordinated and Support Action" (CSA)



Creation of favourable regulatory and market conditions:

- ✓ Remove market barriers
- ✓ Mobilise investment and improve access to finance
- ✓ Improve governance and capacities/skills at all levels
- ✓ Dissemination of knowledge
- ✓ Awareness
- ✓ Education, empowerment



LIFE - Clean Energy Transition (CET) "Coordinated and Support Action" (CSA)

- Engagement of multiple stakeholders in transnational consortiums (exceptions apply for a small number of topics).
- Pre-defined scope: the proposal must respond to call requirements.
 "Top-down approach"
- Interact in the European policy-making process and actively participate in their development
- EU contribution range per project: 1 2 M€
- No equipment costs, no direct investment in infrastructure
- Mainly labour costs (high orgainizational costs)
- 95% co-financing rate
- Indirect costs: 7% of the eligible direct costs (including subcontract costs)

- ✓ Climate Target Plan 2030 & European Climate Law: binding reduction of GHG of at least 55 % in 2030 and a committment to negative emissions by 2050
- ✓ The Renovation Wave: Double the renovation rate by 2030
- ✓ Fit-for-55 review of energy and climate legislation
 - Revision EE Directive
 - Revision RE Directive
 - Revision EPBD Directive
- ✓ REPowerEU: joint action to reduce the dependency of the EU on fossil fuels

- ✓ UE-27 Member States (including overseas countries and territories (OCTs))
- ✓ EFTA countries which are part of the European Economic Area (EEA): *Iceland* agreement signed in September 2021 (retroactive since 01/01/2021)
- ✓ Acceding countries, candidate countries and potential candidates: Albania, Turkey and North Macedonia has expressed interest to participate in the LIFE Programme.
- ✓ European Neighbourhood Policy Countries: Israel, Andorra and Moldova has expressed interest to participate in LIFE. <u>Ukraine</u>, is in ongoing negotiations to participate in the LIFE Programme.
- ✓ Other countries, through specific agreements. *The Faroe Islands* has expressed interest to participate in the LIFE Programme.
- ✓ International Organizations

Important: Applicants from countries which requested to be associated to the LIFE Programme may participate in this call for proposals. However, no grant agreement will be signed if the related association agreement is not entered into force by the finalisation of the evaluation process. The assessment of each proposal will be done in line with the provisions of the relevant association agreement.




